MEXICAN CHAMPIONSHIP J24, 2016

Scheduled from **June 30 to July 3 2016** hosting by Club Marina Sureste., Street 27 Tablaje 5633 Parque Industrial Portuario Yucalpetén, Progreso, Yucatán.

1.- RULES. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in **ISAF 2013 – 2016 (RRV)**, the Mexican Federation Conditions, J/24 International Conditions and the Notice of Race of this event that will provide at registration day in Club Marina Sureste, before the practice regatta on Thursday 30 at 11:00 hrs.

1.1 Boat need to wear the bow number provided by J/24 Class or regatta committee at registration.

1.2 This regatta will be “Closed Park” so any boat that stay the night out of the destined zone during the Championship days will be disqualified.

2.- ELIGIBILITY. Mexican j24 Sailors members of Mexican Federation 2016 and International sailors from J24 International Class.

3.- REGATTA COURSES. The regatta courses will be in front of Yucalpetén beach in Progreso, Yucatan , Mexico. The courses will be windward/ leeward or triangle or a combination thereof

4.- MEASUREMENT. All boat need valid J/24 Measurement Certificate as issued by the IJCA, including the Inventory of Required and Optional Equipment. Boats will be subject to inspection at any time during the regatta.

5.- FEES. Eligible boats may register by completing the online registration process at www.j24yucatan.org

- Early entry (on or before May 10, 2016) - \$1,250 MXP
- Regular entry - \$1,500 MXP

All competitors, including any declared substitute crew members, shall be weighed during registration.

6.- SCHEDULE.

June 30, we have a practice regatta at 12:00 Hrs.

July 1 to 3 the Race Committee intends to run three (3) races on each day of racing at 11:00 hrs.

7.- SAILING INSTRUCTIONS The Sailing Instructions may be available at Registration.

8.- COURSES Will be notified in the Sailing Instructions at Registration.

9.- PENALTIES The Scoring Penalty, RRS 44.3 will apply as modified herein. RRS 44.1 and part of 44.2 (turn penalties) are not in use for this regatta. RRS 44.1(a) and 44.1(b) remain active. Any boat whose rules infringement causes injury or serious damage or gains a significant advantage in the race or series shall retire.

10.- RADIO COMMUNICATIOS The Race Committee intends use VHF (canal 64 USA) all crews must report with regatta comittee each day before the first race of the day.

11.- PUNTUACIÓN When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores. When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. .

12.- PRIZES Prizes will be awarded to the top three boats.

13.- ADVERTISING Advertising for the regatta shall follow ISAF 20. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority. (See ISAF Regulation 20) AND ICJA 2.6.1.

14.- DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY Sailing is an activity that carries with it an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk and are reminded to pay special attention to RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers, including the Race Committee, Jury, the Province of Yucatan, sponsors, volunteers, or any other affiliated organization or official, will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of practice for or participation in this event on the water or ashore. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
